**Please enroll early.** Enrollment is limited and classes fill quickly.

**Registration** will be taken in the order in which the completed forms are received. Students that register by mail assume acceptance unless otherwise notified. Full tuition for the year is due regardless of the number of classes attended unless there is illness or injury followed in writing with a verified doctor's excuse.

**Registration Fee:** \$35 per person or \$40 per family

**Paying in full:** A **10% discount** is offered to all students who pay in full for the year. A 5% discount is offered if paying in full for the semester.

**Paying monthly** \*All students are automatically enrolled in two semesters for the year. If you prefer monthly payments, a \$15 per semester fee is added. The first payment of the semester is due with the registration fee, and final payment of the year is due May 1<sup>st</sup> 2008. Payments are due on the first of each month. After the first of each month, a \$20 late fee is assessed.

**Example:** Pre School A - \$170 a semester or \$40 a month.

### New Automatic Monthly Deduction

You may want to enroll in our Automatic Deduction Plan. Monthly tuition can be automatically deducted from your Credit Card or Check Card. A release form must be submitted.

**Newly enrolled students** - A credit for missed classes will be deducted from your tuition upon enrolling.

*We reserve the right to cancel any class. A minimum enrollment is required for a course to be held.*

**Make up Classes:** If your child is sick or must miss a class, it can be made up at any time that class is scheduled or at a lower level.

## Dress Code

**Girls - (1x week ) Plain black leotard,** pale pink tights, soft pink leather ballet shoes with elastic sewn and strings tucked in. We highly recommend leather split sole Capezio, Freed, or Bloch ballet shoes. Leotards with attached tutus or skirts are not permitted in class.

Hair must be pulled back in a bun at all times. (FYI-Ballerinas do not wear underwear under tights) Pre-Pro division of classes please purchase a Mirella leotard exclusive to your class level.

\*Matching skirts may be worn in the center only.

**Boys-** Plain white T-shirt, black tights, white socks, white leather ballet shoes. Younger boys may wear navy or black gym shorts or black or gray sweat pants.
